



A global team of online tutors and local trainers

A call for applications

The Global Labour University Online Academy is working to build a global team of around 30 enthusiastic online tutors and local trainers engaged in shaping and delivering online labour education. This global team will comprise trade unionists, labour educators and activists keen in getting involved in the process of online education from conceptualisation to online teaching and face-to-face activities.

The selected candidates will be provided with information and training on:

- a) The online education system of the GLU Online Academy and the way the online courses are developed;
- b) Tutoring online courses, including acquiring skills on interactive methods for online education. This would be helpful even for local activities which take place virtually, through for example zoom workshops; and
- c) Developing contextualised modules based on the content of the online courses as well strengthen pedagogical skills for conducting local workshops.

At the end of the training and after conducting at least one local activity, the members of the team will be given a certificate of recognition as online tutors and local trainers of the GLU Online Academy.

After certification applicants will be invited to become free-lance collaborators of the GLU Online Academy Team in conceptualising and delivering online education at national and international level.

Criteria for the selection of the candidates:

The selected candidates should:

- Be trade union member or labour activist
- Be familiar with the online courses of the GLU Online Academy
- Have basic skills in adult education
- Have ability to independently organise and conduct local training activities

The selection process will strive to achieve gender parity as well as coverage for languages, such as: French, Portuguese, Spanish and Russian. All discussions and training will take place in English.
